Dear High School Parent,

Thank you for your interest in Pierrepont School. I have enclosed some literature about the school and an application for admission. Should you choose to apply, here is the procedure:

- The application process requires an individual interview and admissions testing with each applicant, so we encourage submitting the application as soon as possible. The application deadline is January 15, 2012. There is a \$75.00 application fee.
- After we have received your application, we will call to arrange an interview and admissions testing, which consists of a series of activities and questions. If your child has taken an intelligence test recently, please bring in a copy of the results.
- Please send the enclosed *Records Release Form* to your child's school as soon as possible. If your child has attended more than one school, we require a copy of your child's records for all other schools as well.

Give the enclosed *Teacher Evaluation Form* to your child's current teacher. The teacher does not have to return it to us until he or she has had sufficient time to get to know your child. However, we must receive it by January 15. If your child has attended more than one school, we will gladly accept evaluation forms from other schools as well.

Applicants currently in Grades 3 - 4

We require a reading comprehension test that is normed against other independent schools such as the ERB or ISEE. If your child has been tested by ERB/ISEE, results should be sent to our admissions office. If not, please contact the Educational Testing Service for testing sites and dates.

Applicants currently in Grades 5 - 8

We require a math and reading comprehension test that is normed against other independent schools such as the ERB/ISEE. If your child has been tested by ERB/ISEE, a copy of the results should be sent to our admissions office. If not, please contact The Educational Testing Service for testing sites and dates.

Tours of the school start in October, Please call us to schedule an appointment.

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PIERREPONT SCHOOL FINANCIAL AID POLICY AND PROCEDURE

Pierrepont School follows the “Principles of Good Practice for Financial Aid Administration” set out by the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS). In accordance with these principles, all tuition assistance at Pierrepont School is awarded on the basis of financial need, with the understanding that *“the primary responsibility for financing education rests with the family.”*¹ Pierrepont School will make every effort to meet the demonstrated need of all admitted students. We use the School and Student Service for Financial Aid to perform the analysis to determine the financial need of each family. The Pierrepont School Board of Trustees Tuition Assistance Committee awards assistance to families based on this analysis.

Please note:

- Applying for financial aid will not affect admission decisions.
- Pierrepont School does not discriminate in the administration of its financial aid policies because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age in violation of existing state or federal law or regulations.
- Eligibility for financial aid is reviewed annually. Families are expected to *reapply* for aid each year and *to keep the school informed of changes in their financial status*.
- Financial information supplied by each family will be kept in strict confidence.

Parents Financial Aid Statement (PFS)

If you are interested in applying for financial aid, please request a packet from Pierrepont School. You will be mailed a booklet entitled “Parents’ Financial Aid Statement” (PFS) which contains instructions, an application, a worksheet copy, and a return envelope. Please read the instruction booklet carefully, complete the application and submit it to School and Student Services (SSS) as soon as possible.

Tax Returns

You will also be asked to submit a copy of your most recent signed tax return with all accompanying schedules directly to Pierrepont School. This information is used to verify the PFS application.

DEADLINES

December 15, 2011: Last day to submit completed PFS to SSS.

February 1, 2012: Last day to mail tax information to Pierrepont School. Please send a copy of your 2011 return if you have completed it by that date. If not, send a copy of your 2010 return and copies of 2011 income statements (i.e. W-2 or 1099).

Families will be notified of Financial Aid awards in March.
